AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE
OPERATION OF THE LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL
BRANCHES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR THE
FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1970, AND TO
AMEND SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF P.L. 10-33, TENTH
GUAM LEGISLATURE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from
3 any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
4 Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970, for the purposes
5 set forth hereinafter:

6 I. FOR GENERAL GOVERNMENTAL OPERATIONS:

7 A. Courts of Guam \$512,000

8 B. Legislature of Guam

9 1. Operational Expenses 639,104

10 2. Committee Working Fund 50,000

11 3. Legislative Reference Bureau 50,000

12 II. FOR PUBLIC SAFETY:

13 A. Probation Office (Island Court) 60,000

14 Section 2. No travel and transportation expenditures shall
15 be charged to the foregoing appropriation Item I B1.

16 Section 3. Section 3 of Public Law 10-33, Tenth Guam
17 Legislature is hereby amended to read: The Department of Education
18 is hereby authorized to spend over and above the appropriations
19 made by Section 1, (A thru E) of P. L. 10-33, any additional
20 Federal Grants for approved projects upon receipt of said grants.

21 Section 4. Section 4 of Public Law 10-33, Tenth Guam
22 Legislature is hereby amended to read: The University of Guam is

1 hereby authorized to spend over and above the appropriations made
2 by Section 1 of P. L. 10-33, any additional Federal Grants for
3 approved projects upon receipt of said grants.

4 Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
