AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 4116.3 TO THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE  
THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION TO PUBLISH,  
ON A QUARTERLY BASIS, RECLASSIFICATIONS  
OF POSITIONS IN THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4116.3 is hereby added to the Govern-  
3 ment Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 " Section 4116.3. Publication of reclassifications  
5 and new classifications. The Commission shall, not less  
6 than quarterly, cause to be published in a newspaper of  
7 general circulation in the territory, a schedule of all  
8 reclassification actions and all newly established  
9 classifications undertaken by the Commission pursuant  
10 to the provisions of Sections 4116 and 4116.1 of this  
11 Title within the quarter preceding the publication. Such  
12 publication shall include, in the case or reclassifica-  
13 tions, the position title, the number of employees  
14 involved, the previous classification and pay range,  
15 and the new pay range; and, in the case of new classifi-  
16 cations, shall include the position title, the number  
17 of employees involved, and the pay range."
