AN ACT

An Act to add Section 13404 to the Government Code of Guam to authorize the Governor to acquire land needed for recreational facilities.

## Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 13404 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 13404. Acquisition of Recreational Land. The Legislature finds that the acquisition of land to provide recreational facilities fulfills a public purpose and is necessary for the preservation of the health and welfare of the people of Guam. Accordingly, the Governor is authorized to set aside if government owned, and to acquire by negotiations if privately owned, the following amounts of land to be used to provide recreational facilities over the period 1966 thru 1985:

- (1) 45 acres of beaches (6,650 lineal feet of beach):
- (2) 879 picinic units (115 acres);
- (3) 922 camp sits (185 acres);
- (4) Easements for hiking and riding trails of a length of 144 miles;
- (5) 32 acres of land for boating facilities;
- (6) 12 acres of surfing beach land (1,780 lineal feet)."

Section 2. All costs of acquisition shall be paid out of the Land Acquisition Fund established by Section 13977 of the Government Code of Guam.
