

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 15103 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE SALARY FOR GUAM'S
WASHINGTON REPRESENTATIVE, AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 15103 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 15103. Same: compensation and expenses.

5 The Washington Representative shall be paid an annual
6 salary of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) and in
7 addition thereto shall be allowed an annual budget for the
8 purposes of providing round trip transportation from Guam
9 to Washington, D.C., for himself and dependents once each
10 year and to provide for necessary expenses of office rental
11 and such clerical and technical assistance as he may
12 deem in the public interest. In addition, the Washington
13 Representative shall be entitled to an allowance to pro-
14 vide for transportation at government of Guam expense of
15 his household and personal effects, from Guam to Washington,
16 D.C., and upon the termination of his term of office, for
17 whatever cause, to transport such household and personal
18 effects, including his automobile, back to Guam."

19 Section 2. The Pay Range Schedule as established by
20 Section 4103 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended
21 by changing the figures 3042, 3172, 3302, 3432, 3588, 3744,
22 3900, 4082, 4264, 4472, 4680, 4888, 5096, 5304, 5512, 5772,
23 6032, 6292, and 6552, wherever they appear, to read 3354,

1 3484, 3614, 3744, 3900, 4056, 4212, 4370, 4528, 4712, 4896,
2 5080, 5264, 5448, 5632, 5868, 6104, 6340, and 6576, respectively.

3 Section 3. Section 4106 of the Government Code of Guam
4 is hereby amended, where pertinent, to read as follows:

5 "Chief Officer, Public Utility

6 Agency of Guam	\$15,750
7 Commercial Port Manager	\$15,750
8 Director of Agriculture	\$15,750
9 Director of Commerce	\$15,750
10 Director of Land Management	\$15,750
11 Executive Director, Civil	
12 Service Commission	\$15,750 "

13 Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.
