AN ACT ADDING CHAPTER 2 TO TITLE XXXIV OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO ESTABLISH THE MICRONESIAN CULTURAL FAIR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Chapter 2 is hereby added to Title XXXIV of the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"CHAPTER 2

MICRONESIAN CULTURAL FAIR

Section 38100. Policy. It is declared to be the policy of the government of Guam to encourage the development within Micronesia, of which Guam is a part, of strong cultural, commercial, and social bonds encouraging all of the varying peoples and cultures of Micronesia to a friendly interchange of ideas, views, common experiences and common goals. The Legislature finds that such policy is in the best interests of the people of Guam because it will aid the local economy by fostering trade and tourism among the islands, and it will aid the development of Guam's society and culture by broadening the knowledge and interest of the people of Guam in the surrounding islands. It is the further finding of the Legislature that a cultural fair to be held in Guam for the people of Micronesia will carry out this policy.

Section 38101. Authorization of Fair. The Micronesian Cultural Fair is hereby established, such

fair to be held every three years beginning in May of 1971. Such fair shall provide for the participation of all peoples and territories of Micronesia, both in public and private capacities, and will serve to promote the cultural, economic, social, and historical bonds of friendship among the peoples of Micronesia.

Section 38102. Appropriations Authorized. For each third fiscal year beginning with the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971, there is authorized to be appropriated out of moneys in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, such sums as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Chapter.

Section 38103. Direction of Fair. The Board of Regents of the University of Guam is vested with the responsibility of directing the organization and operation of the Micronesian Cultural Fair. It shall have authority to enter into such contracts and to engage in such programs as are necessary to make the fair successful in accomplishing the policy set out in Section 38100 of this Chapter."
