AN ACT ADDING CHAPTER 2 TO TITLE XXXIV
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO
ESTABLISH THE MICRONESIAN CULTURAL FAIR.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Chapter 2 is hereby added to Title XXXIV of
3 the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "CHAPTER 2

5 MICRONESIAN CULTURAL FAIR

6 Section 38100. Policy. It is declared to be the
7 policy of the government of Guam to encourage the
8 development within Micronesia, of which Guam is a part,
9 of strong cultural, commercial, and social bonds
10 encouraging all of the varying peoples and cultures of
11 Micronesia to a friendly interchange of ideas, views,
12 common experiences and common goals. The Legislature
13 finds that such policy is in the best interests of the
14 people of Guam because it will aid the local economy
15 by fostering trade and tourism among the islands, and
16 it will aid the development of Guam's society and
17 culture by broadening the knowledge and interest of the
18 people of Guam in the surrounding islands. It is the
19 further finding of the Legislature that a cultural fair
20 to be held in Guam for the people of Micronesia will
21 carry out this policy.

22 Section 38101. Authorization of Fair. The
23 Micronesian Cultural Fair is hereby established, such

1 fair to be held every three years beginning in May of
2 1971. Such fair shall provide for the participation
3 of all peoples and territories of Micronesia, both in
4 public and private capacities, and will serve to promote
5 the cultural, economic, social, and historical bonds
6 of friendship among the peoples of Micronesia.

7 Section 38102. Appropriations Authorized. For
8 each third fiscal year beginning with the fiscal year
9 ending June 30, 1971, there is authorized to be
10 appropriated out of moneys in the Unappropriated Surplus
11 of the General Fund, such sums as may be necessary to
12 carry out the provisions of this Chapter.

13 Section 38103. Direction of Fair. The Board
14 of Regents of the University of Guam is vested with the
15 responsibility of directing the organization and
16 operation of the Micronesian Cultural Fair. It shall
17 have authority to enter into such contracts and to engage
18 in such programs as are necessary to make the fair
19 successful in accomplishing the policy set out in
20 Section 38100 of this Chapter."
