AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 12320 OF ARTICLE
I OF CHAPTER 4, TITLE XIII, GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO HUNTING BY
ARTIFICIAL LIGHT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 12320 of Article 1, Chapter 4, Title
3 XIII, Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as
4 follows:

5 "S12320. Use of artificial light prohibited. It
6 shall be unlawful for any person to take any game with
7 a spot light or any other artificial light of any kind.
8 To be found with any spot light with any rifle, shotgun
9 or other firearm and with ammunition, after sunset, in
10 any wooded section or other place where any game may
11 reasonably be expected, shall be prima facie evidence
12 of violation of this section. Provided, however, this
13 section shall not apply to the taking of game pursuant
14 to a permit issued in accordance with regulations issued
15 under Section 12321 of this article."

16 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
