AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTIONS 9620.11(b) AND
9621 AND TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 9620.11(b)
AND 9621 IN LIEU THEREOF AND TO ADD NEW
SECTIONS 9620.19(f) AND 9620.24, ALL OF
SUBCHAPTER M, CHAPTER 6, TITLE X, GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO TECHNICAL AMEND-
MENTS OF THE DOG CONTROL LAW.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 9620.11(b) of Subchapter M, Chapter 6,
3 Title X, Government Code of Guam, is hereby repealed and a
4 new Section 9620.11(b) is hereby added in lieu thereof to
5 Subchapter M, Chapter 6, Title X, Government Code of Guam to
6 read as follows:

7 "Section 9620.11(b). Quarantine of Dogs and Cats;

8 All dogs and cats brought into Guam shall be subject to
9 quarantine for a period of time approved by the Director.
10 Requirements for the entry to, and release from, quarantine
11 of dogs and cats brought into Guam shall be in accordance
12 with regulations approved by the Director. Any and all
13 costs, including care and keep, shall be borne by the
14 owner of the animal."

15 Section 2. A new Section 9620.19(f) is hereby added to
16 Subchapter M, Chapter 6, Title X, Government Code of Guam to
17 read as follows:

18 "Section 9620.19(f). It shall be unlawful for any
19 person to wilfully allow a dog owned by him to run at
20 large."

21 Section 3. Section 9621 of Subchapter M, Chapter 6,
22 Title X, Government Code of Guam, is hereby repealed and a
23 new Section 9621 is hereby added in lieu thereof to Subchapter

1 M, Chapter 6, Title X, Government Code of Guam to read as
2 follows:

3 "Section 9621. Penalties. Violation of Subsections
4 (a), (b), (j) or (k) of Section 9620.11 of this sub-
5 chapter shall be punishable by imprisonment not to
6 exceed one year or by a fine not to exceed One Thousand
7 Dollars (\$1,000) or both. Violation of any other provi-
8 sions of this subchapter shall be punishable by a fine
9 not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for the first offense
10 or a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)
11 or imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months or both
12 such fine and imprisonment for a second or subsequent
13 offense. In addition, for a second or subsequent offense,
14 the dog involved may be ordered confiscated for resale
15 or destruction in the discretion of the court."

16 Section 4. A new Section 9620.24 is hereby added to
17 Subchapter M, Chapter 6, Title X, Government Code of Guam,
18 to read as follows:

19 "Section 9620.24. Authority of Officers. All
20 officers as defined by Section 9620.1(c) of this
21 subchapter shall have authority as peace officers to
22 the extent necessary to enable them to discharge all
23 duties assigned to them by law."

24 Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
