AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 288 OF CHAPTER
V, TITLE IX, PART I, PENAL CODE OF GUAM,
RELATIVE TO CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 288 of Chapter V, Title IX, Part I,
Penal Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"§ 288. Crimes Against Children, a Felony. Any
person who shall wilfully and lewdly commit any lewd
or lascivious act including any of the acts constituting
other crimes provided for in Part I of this code upon
or with the body, or any part or member thereof, of a
child under the age of 14 years, with the intent of
arousing, appealing to or gratifying the lust or passions
or sexual desires of such person or of such child, shall
be guilty of a felony and shall be imprisoned for not less
than one year and not more than 15 years."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
