
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO CONSTRUCT  
AND IMPROVE THE INALADO ROAD TO CONNECT  
PAGO BAY TO ROUTE NO. 10 AND TO PAVE THE  
MAIMAI ROAD FROM ROUTE 4 TO THE END OF SAID  
MAIMAI ROAD.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any  
3 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General  
4 Fund the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to  
5 construct a public road along the right of way known as the  
6 "Inalado Road" so as to connect Pago Bay to Route No. 10.

7 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any  
8 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General  
9 Fund the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) to pave  
10 the Maimai Road from Route 4 to the end of said Maimai Road.
