

AN ACT TO RENUMBER SECTION 13977 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM SECTION 13978
AND TO ENACT A NEW SECTION 13977 TO
REQUIRE THE DIRECTOR OF LAND MANAGEMENT
TO SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT OF THE REQUIRED
SURVEY OF GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE LANDS
AUTHORIZED BY CHAPTER 12 OF TITLE XIV OF
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 13977 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby renumbered Section 13978 and a new Section 13977 is
4 hereby enacted to read as follows:

5 "Section 13977. Director to submit annual report.

6 The Director of Land Management shall prepare annually
7 and submit to the Legislature, through the Governor, a
8 report setting out all activities by the Department of
9 Land Management and Territorial Surveyor in carrying
10 out the survey of government land as required by Section
11 13970 of this Chapter and the survey of private land as
12 authorized by Section 13972 of this Chapter. Such
13 report shall be submitted on or before July 5th of each
14 year and shall cover the survey activities of the
15 department and of the Territorial Surveyor for the
16 immediately preceding fiscal year."
