

AN ACT AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF TITLE VI OF
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE THE
LEGISLATURE TO ADVISE AS WELL AS CONSENT
TO THE APPOINTMENTS OF THE HEADS OF EXECU-
TIVE AGENCIES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 5100 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5100. Department of Administration. There
5 is within the Executive Branch of the government of Guam
6 a Department of Administration. The Director of Adminis-
7 tration is the head of the Department of Administration.
8 The Director of Administration is appointed by the
9 Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislature."

10 Section 2. Section 5101 of the Government Code of Guam
11 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 5101. Department of Law. There is within
13 the Executive Branch of the government of Guam a Depart-
14 ment of Law. The Attorney General is the head of the
15 Department of Law. The Attorney General is appointed by
16 the Governor with the advice and consent of the
17 Legislature."

18 Section 3. Section 5102 of the Government Code of Guam
19 is hereby amended to read as follows:

20 "Section 5102. Department of Public Safety. There
21 is within the Executive Branch of the government of Guam
22 a Department of Public Safety. The Director of Public
23 Safety is the head of the Department of Public Safety.
24 The Director of Public Safety is appointed by the Governor
25 with the advice and consent of the Legislature."

1 Section 4. Section 5104 of the Government Code of Guam
2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 5104. Department of Public Works. There is
4 within the Executive Branch of the government of Guam a
5 Department of Public Works. The Director of Public Works
6 is the head of the Department of Public Works. The
7 Director of Public Works is appointed by the Governor
8 with the advice and consent of the Legislature."

9 Section 5. Section 5106 of the Government Code of Guam
10 is hereby amended to read as follows:

11 "Section 5106. Department of Agriculture. There is
12 within the Executive Branch of the government of Guam
13 a Department of Agriculture. The Director of Agriculture
14 is the head of the Department of Agriculture. The
15 Director of Agriculture is appointed by the Governor with
16 the advice and consent of the Legislature."

17 Section 6. Section 5107 of the Government Code of Guam
18 is hereby amended to read as follows:

19 "Section 5107. Department of Land Management. There
20 is within the Executive Branch of the government of Guam
21 a Department of Land Management. The Director of Land
22 Management is the head of the Department of Land
23 Management. The Director of Land Management is appointed
24 by the Governor with the advice and consent of the
25 Legislature."

26 Section 7. Section 5108 of the Government Code of Guam
27 is hereby amended to read as follows:

28 "Section 5108. Department of Commerce. There is
29 within the Executive Branch of the government of Guam
30 a Department of Commerce. The Director of Commerce is the
31 head of the Department of Commerce. The Director of

1 Commerce is appointed by the Governor with the advice
2 and consent of the Legislature."

3 Section 8. Section 5110 of the Government Code of Guam
4 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 "Section 5110. Department of Public Health and
6 Social Services. There is within the Executive Branch
7 of the government of Guam a Department of Public Health
8 and Social Services, the head of which is the Director
9 of Public Health and Social Services. The Director of
10 Public Health and Social Services is appointed by the
11 Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislature."

12 Section 9. Section 5111 of the Government Code of Guam
13 is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 "Section 5111. Department of Labor. There is within
15 the Executive Branch of the government of Guam a
16 Department of Labor. The Director of Labor is the head
17 of the Department of Labor. The Director of Labor is
18 appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent
19 of the Legislature."

20 Section 10. Section 5112 of the Government Code of Guam
21 is hereby amended to read as follows:

22 "Section 5112. Department of Corrections. There is
23 within the Executive Branch of the government of Guam
24 a Department of Corrections. The Director of Corrections
25 is the head of the Department of Corrections. The
26 Director of Corrections is appointed by the Governor with
27 the advice and consent of the Legislature."

28 Section 11. Section 5113 of the Government Code of Guam
29 is hereby amended to read as follows:

30 "Section 5113. Department of Revenue and Taxation.
31 There is within the Executive Branch of the government

of Guam a Department of Revenue and Taxation. The
Director of Revenue and Taxation is the head of the
Department of Revenue and Taxation. The Director of
Revenue and Taxation is appointed by the Governor with
the advice and consent of the Legislature."
