

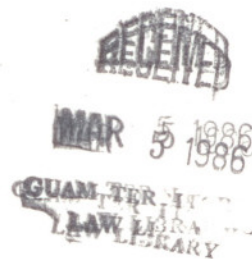

AN ACT CREATING THE CODES OF GUAM
PRINTING FUND AND MAKING AN APPRO-
PRIATION THERETO.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Creation of Codes of Guam Printing Fund.

3 There is hereby created a special revolving fund within the
4 government of Guam, hereby designated the "Codes of Guam Printing
5 Fund."

6 (a) All monies received from the sale of the Codes of
7 Guam shall be credited to the account of the Fund and all
8 expenses related to the codification of the laws of Guam and
9 the printing of the Codes shall be charged to the Fund.

10 (b) All accounting records pertaining to the Fund shall
11 be maintained separate and apart from the accounting records of
12 other funds of the government.

13 (c) All appropriations made after July 1, 1968 and all
14 expenditures and obligations against those appropriations,
15 including non-obligated and non-expended balances thereof, shall
16 be transferred from the General Fund to the Codes of Guam
17 Printing Fund.

18 (d) The books of accounts, and supporting records
19 therefor, shall be maintained by the Administrative Assistant
20 of the Guam Legislature, or by his delegate, which delegation
21 shall be in writing. The Administrative Assistant shall prepare
22 a monthly report on the operations and transactions of the Fund
23 which shall be furnished to every member of the Legislature
24 within 15 days of the end of every month. He shall also be
25 responsible for the proper protection and accountability of all
26 property assets of the Fund, excluding cash which shall be

1 deposited with the Treasurer of Guam.

2 (e) The Treasurer of Guam shall be the treasurer of the
3 fund and shall receive all monies accruing into the fund,
4 depositing same in an authorized depository, and shall disburse
5 from the Fund only upon presentation of a certified voucher
6 signed by the Chairman of the Committee on Rules, accompanied
7 by a certified copy of a resolution in writing adopted by a
8 majority of the members of the Rules Committee.

9 (f) The printing and binding of the codes and supple-
10 ments thereto shall be under the direction of the editor and
11 codifier heretofore selected by the Guam Legislature through
12 its Committee on Rules. He shall make written recommendations
13 to said committee as to the method of contracting for said
14 printing and binding and shall cause to be published, in a
15 newspaper of general circulation in the territory, a notice
16 soliciting proposals for said printing and binding.

17 (g) The sale and distribution of all Codes and supple-
18 ments thereto shall be made under such conditions and such
19 prices as may from time to time be fixed in resolutions adopted
20 by the Legislature.

21 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any
22 available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General
23 Fund the sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) to the
24 Codes of Guam Printing Fund.

25 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
