


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR  
NECESSARY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated  
3 from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of  
4 the General Fund for capital improvements and other purposes  
5 indicated opposite the amounts.

6	A. Construction of Restrooms, Concrete	
7	Walks, Outdoor Showers (Agana	
8	Recreation Park)	\$ 18,315
9	B. Group Life Insurance	53,000
10	C. Eradication of the Melon Fruit Fly	130,000
11	D. Study and control of the Acanthaster	
12	Planci (University of Guam)	27,000

13 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the  
14 Abandoned Vehicle Fund established by Public Law 9-42, effec-  
15 tive immediately, the sum of \$50,000 for the purpose of  
16 removing all abandoned vehicles found on public and private  
17 properties on Guam, which abandoned vehicles shall be disposed  
18 of by sinking them in the reef waters of the territory to be  
19 used in improving the fisheries of Guam.

20 Section 3. The appropriations made by this Act shall be  
21 available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which  
22 made. All appropriations made hereby shall continue in full  
23 force and effect until expended for the project for which

1       appropriated or until the project is completed.

2               Section 4. (All expenditures not to exceed fifty thousand  
3 dollars for the survey and replatting of Harmon Field in the  
4 municipality of Dededo as authorized by Bill 154, Tenth Guam  
5 Legislature, shall be charged to the Land Survey Fund of the  
6 government of Guam.)

7               Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
