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
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 17052 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO ZONE AN AREA IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO FOR CHURCH AND CHURCH RELATED ACTIVITIES AND TO AMEND P.L. 9-192 TO REMOVE ONE PARCEL OF LAND FROM ITS OPERATION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 17052 is hereby added to the
3 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 17052. Church Zone in Dededo. As an
5 amendment to the Dededo Zoning Map, (Land Management
6 Drawing No. E3-67S39) adopted by the Committee on
7 Rules of the Guam Legislature pursuant to the pro-
8 visions of Section 17050 of this title, the area
9 in the municipality of Dededo, bounded by West Santa
10 Monica Avenue to the north, Dolores Street to the
11 east, and West San Antonio Avenue to the south and
11 west, is hereby declared to be zoned for church
12 and church-related activities."

13 Section 2. Subsection (a) of Section 2 of Public Law
14 9-192, Ninth Guam Legislature, is hereby amended to read as
15 follows:

16 "(a) In the manner hereinafter set out, the
17 Governor is authorized to enter into a contract or
18 contracts with any person, partnership or corporation,
19 for the construction and erection of residential
20 houses for sale to the people of Guam on those parcels
21 of government-owned land in the municipality of
22 of Dededo described as Parcels 1, 4, and 5, as shown
23 on Land Management Drawing No. E4-68S650, dated
24 January 26, 1968."
