AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 204.1 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO DECLARE THE FIRST MONDAY OF JANUARY BEGINNING JANUARY 1971, AND EVERY FOUR YEARS THEREAFTER GUBERNATORIAL INAUGURATION DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Section 204.1 is hereby added to the
Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 204.1. Gubernatorial Inauguration
Day. The first Monday of January of every fourth
year beginning January 1971, is a holiday designated
the 'Gubernatorial Inauguration Day', on Which day
the Governor and Lieutenant Governor elected in the
general election preceding such day shall be sworn
into office. The inauguration ceremony shall be
arranged by the incumbent Governor who shall
coordinate his activities in connection therewith with
the governor-elect."
