
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 204.1 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO DECLARE
THE FIRST MONDAY OF JANUARY BEGIN-
NING JANUARY 1971, AND EVERY FOUR
YEARS THEREAFTER GUBERNATORIAL
INAUGURATION DAY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 204.1 is hereby added to the
3 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 204.1. Gubernatorial Inauguration
5 Day. The first Monday of January of every fourth
6 year beginning January 1971, is a holiday designated
7 the 'Gubernatorial Inauguration Day', on which day
8 the Governor and Lieutenant Governor elected in the
9 general election preceding such day shall be sworn
10 into office. The inauguration ceremony shall be
11 arranged by the incumbent Governor who shall
12 coordinate his activities in connection therewith with
13 the governor-elect."
