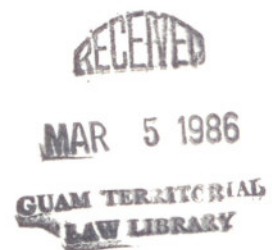

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A FIVE-YEAR PAVING
PROGRAM FOR VILLAGE STREETS AND AUTHORIZING
AN APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,360,000
TO FINANCE SUCH PROGRAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Five-Year Street Improvement Program; Adminis-
3 tration. There is hereby created a program to provide village
4 streets with asphalt concrete paving over a period of five
5 years, commencing July 1, 1970. The administration of this pro-
6 gram shall be under the supervision of the Director of the
7 Department of Public Works. No funds hereinafter provided for
8 this program may be used to pay for any easement or other land-
9 taking in connection with the program, or to finance any
10 street improvement within any private subdivision not in
11 existence at the effective date of this Act.

12 Section 2. Village Street Improvement Fund. There is
13 hereby created the Street Improvement Fund to be used to
14 finance street improvements pursuant to this Act. There is
15 authorized to be appropriated to said Fund from the Unappro-
16 priated Surplus of the General Fund over the five years of the
17 program authorized by this Act the sum of \$6,360,000 to be
18 apportioned among the municipal districts of Guam as follows:

21 The total authorized hereunder shall be appropriated annually
22 from the proceeds of the liquid fuel tax, in the following
23 manner: For fiscal year 1971, \$1,200,000; for fiscal year 1972,
24 \$1,200,000; for fiscal year 1973, \$1,200,000; for fiscal year
25 1974, \$1,200,000; and for fiscal year 1975, \$1,550,000. No
26 such funds after being so appropriated may be used for any
27 other purpose.
