




Introduced by E. S. Terlaje

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 5010 TO THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE  
FOR AN ORDERLY TRANSITION BETWEEN  
ADMINISTRATIONS AND AUTHORIZING  
APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 5010 is hereby added to the Government  
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 5010. Transition in Office of Governor.

5 For the period following the election of the Governor of  
6 Guam in November of every fourth year beginning in 1970,  
7 the then incumbent Governor, if not the successful  
8 candidate, shall assist the Governor-elect in preparing  
9 for his new duties until he assumes office in January of  
10 the year following his election. Such assistance by the  
11 incumbent Governor shall include making available to the  
12 Governor-elect or his designees office space, office  
13 supplies and clerical assistance. In addition, the  
14 incumbent Governor shall assist the Governor-elect in  
15 acquainting the latter with the operation of the govern-  
16 ment with the end in view that the transition between  
17 administrations will go smoothly and not interrupt the  
18 orderly transaction of public affairs."

19 Section 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated  
20 from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the  
21 General Fund the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) every  
22 four years, commencing in 1970, to carry out the provisions of  
23 Section 5010 of the Government Code of Guam.

24 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
