AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 5010 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN TO PROVIDE FOR AN ORDERLY TRANSITION BETWEEN ADMINISTRATIONS AND AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATIONS THEREFOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 5010 is hereby added to the Government

Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 5010. Transition in Office of Governor.

For the period following the election of the Governor of Guam in November of every fourth year beginning in 1970, the then incumbent Governor, if not the successful candidate, shall assist the Governor-elect in preparing for his new duties until he assumes office in January of the year following his election. Such assistance by the incumbent Governor shall include making available to the Governor-elect or his designees office space, office supplies and clerical assistance. In addition, the incumbent Governor shall assist the Governor-elect in acquainting the latter with the operation of the government with the end in view that the transition between administrations will go smoothly and not interrupt the orderly transaction of public affairs."

Section 2. There is horeby authorized to be appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) every four years, commencing in 1970, to carry out the provisions of Section 5010 of the Government Code of Guam.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
