AN ACT TO RESERVE CERTAIN GOVERNMENT LAND IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO TO ESTABLISH A REGIONAL PLAYGROUND AND RECREATIONAL AREA AND TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CIVIC AND CULTURAL AUDITORIUM ON GOVERNMENT LAND IN AGANA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Reservation of government land. That parcel of land owned by the government of Guam in the municipality of Dededo, designated Parcel 2, consisting of approximately 270 acres, and shown on Land Management Drawing No. E4-68S650, is hereby reserved and set aside for use as a regional playground and recreational area; provided, however, that a portion of Parcel 2 may be utilized for a public school site.

Section 2. Facilities for area. There shall be constructed on the recreational area so reserved by this Act public recreational, cultural, educational and promotional facilities, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, a baseball park, a track and field stadium, a cultural auditorium, facilities for displaying cultural and other artifacts and exhibits.

Section 3. Administration of area. The Director of Land Management, in consultation with the Guam Recreation Commission and with those local civic and cultural associations interested in public recreation and improvement, shall be responsible for the administration of the area reserved by this Act and for the facilities to be constructed thereat.
