


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

Introduced by R. F. Taitano

AN ACT TO RESERVE CERTAIN GOVERNMENT  
LAND IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO TO  
ESTABLISH A REGIONAL PLAYGROUND AND  
RECREATIONAL AREA AND TO AUTHORIZE THE  
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM TO ENTER INTO A  
LEASE AGREEMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF  
A CIVIC AND CULTURAL AUDITORIUM ON  
GOVERNMENT LAND IN AGANA.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Reservation of government land. That parcel  
3 of land owned by the government of Guam in the municipality of  
4 Dededo, designated Parcel 2, consisting of approximately 270  
5 acres, and shown on Land Management Drawing No. E4-68S650, is  
6 hereby reserved and set aside for use as a regional playground  
7 and recreational area; provided, however, that a portion of  
8 Parcel 2 may be utilized for a public school site.

9 Section 2. Facilities for area. There shall be con-  
10 structed on the recreational area so reserved by this Act public  
11 recreational, cultural, educational and promotional facilities,  
12 including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, a  
13 baseball park, a track and field stadium, a cultural auditorium,  
14 facilities for displaying cultural and other artifacts and  
15 exhibits.

16 Section 3. Administration of area. The Director of Land  
17 Management, in consultation with the Guam Recreation Commission  
18 and with those local civic and cultural associations interested  
19 in public recreation and improvement, shall be responsible for  
20 the administration of the area reserved by this Act and for the  
21 facilities to be constructed thereat.
