

Introduced by A. C. Cruz

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 10-36, TENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, TO CLARIFY THE RETIREMENT PRIVILEGES OF THOSE TEMPORARY GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES MADE PERMANENT ON JULY 1, 1964 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law 10-36, Tenth Guam Legislature, is  
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 2. The employment status of those temporary employees of  
5 the Public Utility Agency of Guam, and of the Department of Public Works, the  
6 latter commonly referred to as the 'Construction Battalion', shall be con-  
7 verted as of the effective date of this Act from 'temporary' to 'permanent';  
8 subject to the following conditions:

9 (a) Initial appointment shall be probationary, in accord with the  
10 Personnel Rules and Regulations;

11 (b) Such employees shall retain their current class titles, subject  
12 to classification study, following which compensation shall be adjusted to  
13 the first step of the pay range of the position determined by such study;

14 (c) For purposes of calculating leave and retirement benefits, such  
15 employees, including those age sixty or over on July 1, 1964, shall be cre-  
16 dited with their temporary service prior to July 1, 1964, except that to  
17 obtain such retirement credit, such employees must pay into the fund or enter  
18 into binding agreements to so pay, the amount of contributions they would  
19 have made to the fund had they been permanent employees at the time of their  
20 temporary service. No such employee may be denied membership in the re-  
21 tirement fund solely because he was over the age of 60 years on July 1, 1964.  
22 The amount of contributions to be paid into the fund shall be paid in a lump  
23 sum or in installments under rules prescribed by the Board of Trustees of the

1 fund. The amount of contributions to be paid into the fund by the government  
2 of Guam shall be determined by applying the applicable percentage rate to the  
3 total wages paid to such employees."

4 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
