AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 9-192 TO ALLOW RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT OF GOVERNMENT LAND IN AGAT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Section 2(a) of Public Law 9-192 is amended
to read as follows:

"(a) In the manner hereinafter set out, the
Governor is authorized to enter into a contract or
contracts with any person, partnership or corporation,
for the construction and erection of residential houses
for sale to the people of Guam on those parcels of
government-owned land in the municipality of Dededo
described as Parcels 1, 4, and 5, as shown on Land
Management Drawing No. E-4-683650 dated January 26, 1968,
and government-owned land in the municipality of Agat
described as Lots Nos. 350 and 194-2-3 as shown on Land
Management Drawing No. D4-63T201."
