AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4006.1 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO MATERNITY LEAVE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. Section 4006.1 of the Government Code of Guam
is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4006.1. Maternity Leave. The personnel rules required by Section 4006 shall provide that confinement for childbirth will be considered as sickness, and that any female employed of the government of Guam who is absent from work because of her confinement for childbirth shall be paid from accumulated sick leave for absence for this purpose not to exceed fifteen (15) days; provided, however, that in the event such an employee is absent for more than fifteen (15) days because of her confinement for childbirth, she shall have such excess days charged against any accumulated sick leave remaining rather than against her annual leave until all her accumulated sick leave is exhausted."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
