
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

Introduced by A. C. Cruz

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4006.1 OF THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO  
MATERNITY LEAVE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4006.1 of the Government Code of Guam  
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 4006.1. Maternity Leave. The personnel  
5 rules required by Section 4006 shall provide that  
6 confinement for childbirth will be considered as sickness,  
7 and that any female employee of the government of Guam who  
8 is absent from work because of her confinement for child-  
9 birth shall be paid from accumulated sick leave for absence  
10 for this purpose not to exceed fifteen (15) days; pro-  
11 vided, however, that in the event such an employee is  
12 absent for more than fifteen (15) days because of her  
13 confinement for childbirth, she shall have such excess  
14 days charged against any accumulated sick leave remaining  
15 rather than against her annual leave until all her  
16 accumulated sick leave is exhausted."

17 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
