




AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 2103 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO INCREASE
THE COMPENSATION PAID MEMBERS OF
PRECINCT BOARDS IN TERRITORIAL ELECC-
TIONS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 2103 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 2103. Same: members and compensation.

5 To each and every polling place designated, the Commission shall
6 appoint a precinct board consisting of an inspector, two judges and
7 two clerks.

8 The concurrence of two members shall be necessary for any ruling
9 of the precinct board. The two clerks shall have no vote.

10 All members of the precinct boards shall be paid twenty-five
11 (\$25.00) dollars each for services rendered for each election."

12 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
