


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

Introduced by E. S. Terlaje

AN ACT TO ADD CHAPTER 13 TO TITLE
IX OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM
TO PROVIDE PAYMENT OF BONUSES TO
PERSONS WHO SERVED WITH THE MILITARY
OR NAVAL FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES
IN THE KOREAN WAR OR IN THE VIETNAM
CONFLICT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Chapter 13 is hereby added to Title IX of
3 the Government Code of Guam to read:

4 "CHAPTER 13

5 VETERANS BONUSES

6 Section 8975. Veterans entitled to bonus; Amount.
7 Every person who served in active duty in the military
8 or naval service of the United States in the Korean War
9 or in the Vietnam Conflict, who, at the time of entering
10 such service, was a resident of Guam, and who is honorably
11 separated or discharged from such service, or who is still
12 in active or reserve service, and who was in such service
13 for a period of at least ninety days, shall be entitled
14 to receive a veteran's bonus of fifteen dollars for each
15 month of active service during the Korean War ^{in Korea} or in the
16 Vietnam Conflict, ^{in Vietnam} or in both. The bonus for a fraction
17 of a month of service shall be determined on the basis of
18 fifty cents for each day of service, except that bonuses
19 shall not be given to any person who received from another
20 state or territory a bonus of a like nature as is pro-
21 vided by this Chapter.

1 Section 8976. Application for bonus. All applications
2 for the bonuses authorized by this Chapter must be made
3 to the Department of Administration before July 1, 1971.

4 Section 8977. Rules and Regulations. The Director
5 of Administration, pursuant to the provisions of the
6 Administrative Adjudication Act, shall issue all lawful
7 rules and regulations needed to implement the provisions
8 of this Chapter, including, without limitation, criteria
9 governing length of service and type of discharge, and
10 defining the beginnings and ends of the Korean War and
11 the Vietnam Conflict."

12 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
