


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

Introduced by A. C. Cruz

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (h) OF SECTION
4233 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO
PERMIT MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE TO WITH-
DRAW FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM RETIREMENT
SYSTEM UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection (h) of Section 4233 of the Govern-
3 ment Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(h) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this
5 section, the provisions hereof shall not apply to any
6 member of the Legislature who, while serving therein, is
7 already receiving benefits under this Chapter as a result
8 of service in any other department, division or agency of
9 the government of Guam, or U. S. Government. In addition,
10 any member of the Legislature, who while serving therein,
11 receives retirement benefits from the United States as a
12 result of service for the United States Government, may
13 elect to not become a member of the Government of Guam
14 Retirement System, in which case, if he has previously
15 been a member thereof on account of his legislative ser-
16 vice, he shall be entitled to withdraw from the Fund all
17 his contributions thereto."

18 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
