AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (h) OF SECTION 4233 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PERMIT MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE TO WITH-DRAW FROM THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM RETIREMENT SYSTEM UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subsection (h) of Section 4233 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(h) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, the provisions hereof shall not apply to any member of the Legislature who, while serving therein, is already receiving benefits under this Chapter as a result of service in any other department, division or agency of the government of Guam, or U. S. Government. In addition, any member of the Legislature, who while serving therein, receives retirement benefits from the United States as a result of service for the United States Government, may elect to not become a member of the Government of Guam Retirement System, in which case, if he has previously been a member thereof on account of his legislative service, he shall be entitled to withdraw from the Fund all his contributions thereto."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
