



AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM FOR VILLAGE DRAINAGE AND AUTHORIZING AN APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,507,000 TO FINANCE SUCH PROGRAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Village Drainage Improvement Program; Adminis-
3 tration. There is hereby created a program to provide badly
4 needed village drainage systems, including, without limitation,
5 culverts, ditches, causeways, dikes and bridges, commencing
6 July 1, 1970. The administration of this program shall be under
7 the supervision of the Director of the Department of Public
8 Works. No funds hereinafter provided for this program may be
9 used to pay for any easement or other landtaking in connection
10 with the program, or to finance any drainage improvement within
11 any private subdivision not in existence at the effective day
12 of this Act.

13 Section 2. Village Drainage Improvement Fund. There is
14 hereby created the Drainage Improvement Fund to be used to
15 finance village drainage system pursuant to this Act. There is
16 authorized to be appropriated to said Fund from the Unappro-
17 priated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$3,507,000 to be
18 apportioned among the municipal districts of Guam as follows:

Asan	\$ 380,000
Piti	327,000
Santa Rita-Agat	1,700,000
Merizo	570,000
Agana-Anigua	500,000
Inarajan	30,000

26 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
