AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM FOR VILLAGE DRAINAGE AND AUTHORIZING AN APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,507,000 TO FINANCE SUCH PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Village Drainage Improvement Program; Administration. There is hereby created a program to provide badly needed village drainage systems, including, without limitation, culverts, ditches, causeways, dikes and bridges, commencing July 1, 1970. The administration of this program shall be under the supervision of the Director of the Department of Public Works. No funds hereinafter provided for this program may be used to pay for any easement or other landtaking in connection with the program, or to finance any drainage improvement within any private subdivision not in existence at the effective day of this Act.

Section 2. Village Drainage Improvement Fund. There is hereby created the Drainage Improvement Fund to be used to finance village drainage system pursuant to this Act. There is authorized to be appropriated to said Fund from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$3,507,000 to be apportioned among the municipal districts of Guam as follows:
