CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AN APPROPRIATION
TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF A PREPAID
HEALTH PLAN FOR THE TERRITORY, TO SELECT
A SITE FOR THE GUAM MEMORIAL COMPLEX, AND
TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF OBTAINING
FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN CONSTRUC-
TING A NEW HOSPITAL COMPLEX.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
3 from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the
4 General Fund the sum of Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000)
5 to Guam Memorial Hospital to undertake a study to determine the
6 feasibility of a prepaid health plan for the territory of Guam,
7 to be based on the utilization of a Health Care Center complex
8 as is described in the Planning Study Report for Guam Memorial
9 Hospital, dated June 8, 1969, and to select a site for the
10 Guam Memorial Hospital complex.

11 Section 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated
12 from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the
13 General Fund the sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000)
14 to Guam Memorial Hospital to undertake a study to determine the
15 availability of obtaining Federal Financial Assistance in
16 constructing and furnishing the Health Care Center complex so
17 recommended in the Planning Study Report for Guam Memorial
18 Hospital, dated June 8, 1969.

19 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
