AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AN APPROPRIATION
TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF A PREPAID
HEALTH PLAN FOR THE TERRITORY, TO SELECT
A SITE FOR THE GUAN MEMORIAL COMPLEX, AND
TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF OBTAINING
FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN CONSTRUCTING A NEW HOSPITAL COMPLEX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000) to Guam Memorial Hospital to undertake a study to determine the feasibility of a prepaid health plan for the territory of Guam, to be based on the utilization of a Health Care Center complex as is described in the Planning Study Report for Guam Memorial Hospital, dated June 8, 1969, and to select a site for the Guam Memorial Hospital complex.

Section 2. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Pund the sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) to Guam Memorial Hospital to undertake a study to determine the availability of obtaining Federal Financial Assistance in constructing and furnishing the Health Care Center complex so recommended in the Flanning Study Report for Guam Memorial Hospital, dated Junc 8, 1969.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
