Introduced by R. F. Taitano

AN ACT AUTHORIZING A FIVE-YEAR PROGRAM
TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE FENCES FOR THE PUBLIC
SCHOOLS BEGINNING IN FISCAL YEAR 1970.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Statement of Findings. The Legislature finds
3 that the public elementary and secondary schools of the territory
4 are for the most part lacking an essential feature for the
5 protection of the students, namely, adequate fences; this lack
6 causing many problems, among them being, in the elementary
7 schools, the possibility that the young children will run out
8 into the streets, and in the secondary schools the problems
9 caused by school dropouts and other persons not actually enroll-
10 ed in the public schools hanging around the students on the
11 school premises. It is therefore the further finding of the
12 Legislature that the provision of fences for all of the schools
13 should be undertaken on an extended basis.

14 Section 2. Authorization for Appropriation. There is
15 hereby authorized to be appropriated over a five-year period
16 commencing July 1, 1969, the sum of One Million Dollars
17 (\$1,000,000.00) from any available funds in the Unappropriated
18 Surplus of the General Fund, such appropriations to be used to
19 provide adequate safety fences for all of the public elementary
20 and secondary schools of Guam.
