Introduced by A. S. N. Flores

AN ACT MAKING AMENDMENTS TO SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 9-121, NINTH GUAM LEGISLATURE, TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF THE LOANS FOR FARMERS TO \$10,000 AND TO PERMIT A 10 YEAR TERM FOR SUCH LOANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law 9-121, Ninth Guam Legislature, is hereby amended to read as follows:

> "Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) to be used as a Farmers Small Loan Revolving Fund. The Governor shall by executive order promulgate all rules and regulations necessary to the operation of this fund; provided, however, that loans granted under this fund shall not exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), each, that the term of such loans shall be ten years and that interest charged on each such loan shall be 2% per annum, and provided further that no such loan shall be made, directly or indirectly, to any member of the Legislature."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
