

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR OVER-
EXPENDITURES OF VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from
3 any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the
4 General Fund to cover over-expenditures of certain prior
5 appropriations for various capital improvements and for other
