


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR OVER-  
EXPENDITURES OF THE OPERATION OF THE  
EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE BRANCHES OF  
THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR THE FISCAL  
YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1969, AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated  
3 from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the  
4 General Fund to cover over-expenditures of prior appropriations  
5 made for operation of Executive and Legislative branches for  
6 fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 and for other purposes.

7                    Section 2. None of the appropriation made by Section 1 of  
8 this Act shall take effect until the Governor of Guam with  
9 respects to over-expenditures for the Executive Branch and the  
10 Chairman of the Committee on Rules of the Guam Legislature shall  
11 have transmitted to the Legislature all the reports required by  
12 Subsection (e) of Section 6118 of the Government Code of Guam for  
13 the over-expenditures to be covered by the appropriations of said  
14 Section 1 of this Act.

15                    Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
