
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CONTRI-
BUTION TO THE PUBLIC UTILITY AGENCY OF GUAM
FUND AND TO THE SCHOOL LUNCH FUND TO COVER
ILLEGAL ADVANCES MADE FROM THE GENERAL
FUND DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE
30, 1969.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The sum of Five Hundred Eighteen Thousand Nine
3 Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$518,921.00) is hereby appropriated
4 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund as a contri-
5 bution to the Public Utility Agency of Guam Fund for illegal ad-
6 vances made to said Fund from the General Fund during the fiscal
7 year ending June 30, 1969.

8 Section 2. This Act shall not take effect until the
9 Governor of Guam shall have transmitted to the Guam Legislature
10 all the reports required by Subsection (e) of Section 6118 of the
11 Government Code of Guam and a progress report on actions taken
12 with respect to the recommendation made by the Government Comp-
13 troller contained in said Comptroller's report on Bill No. 273 of
14 the Tenth Guam Legislature of August, 1969.

15 Section 3. The sum of Two Hundred Twenty Seven Thousand
16 Three Hundred Forty-Eight Dollars (\$227,348) is hereby appro-
17 priated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund as a
18 contribution to the School Lunch Fund for advances made to said
19 Fund from the General Fund during the fiscal year ending June 30,
20 1969.

21 Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.
