## AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE STUDENT SUMMER EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars \$(\$150,000) effective immediately to implement the Student Summer Employment Program. Section 2. Not later than September 30, 1970, the Chairman of the Governor's Committee on Children and Youth shall submit a report to the Legislature via the Governor of Guam containing therein (a) a complete list of the names, age, and village address of all students who participated in the program; (b) his evaluation of the effectiveness of the Student Employment Program; (c) the hours spent by each student on any project or agency of government; and (d) the work or training accomplished by each student.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) to Guam Memorial Hospital to determine the feasibility of a prepaid health plan for the territory of Guam.

Section 4. Appropriations made by Section 3 of this Act shall be effective July 1, 1970 and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project or until the project is completed.
