



AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE STUDENT
SUMMER EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available
3 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the
4 sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) effective
5 immediately to implement the Student Summer Employment Program.

6 Section 2. Not later than September 30, 1970, the Chairman
7 of the Governor's Committee on Children and Youth shall submit
8 a report to the Legislature via the Governor of Guam containing
9 therein (a) a complete list of the names, age, and village
10 address of all students who participated in the program; (b)
11 his evaluation of the effectiveness of the Student Employment
12 Program; (c) the hours spent by each student on any project
13 or agency of government; and (d) the work or training accomplish-
14 ed by each student.

15 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from any available
16 balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund
17 the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) to Guam
18 Memorial Hospital to determine the feasibility of a prepaid
19 health plan for the territory of Guam.

20 Section 4. Appropriations made by Section 3 of this Act
21 shall be effective July 1, 1970 and shall be available for all
22 expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Appropriation
23 made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall
24 be available until expended for the project or until the project
25 is completed.

26 Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
