



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE  
HOUSING REVOLVING FUND AND TO SET UP  
A RESERVE FOR ADVANCES MADE TO THE  
PUBLIC UTILITY AGENCY OF GUAM AND THE  
COMMERCIAL PORT OF GUAM FROM THE GENERAL  
FUND.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any  
3 available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General  
4 Fund the sum of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000) Dollars to the  
5 Housing Revolving Fund to cover anticipated operating losses  
6 as of June 30, 1970.

7 Section 2. There is hereby reserved within the Unappro-  
8 priated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Million Two  
9 Hundred Forty-Four Thousand (\$1,244,000) Dollars, to cover  
10 anticipated operating losses as of June 30, 1970 of the  
11 Commercial Port of Guam Fund and the Public Utility Agency of  
12 Guam Fund. The amount so reserved may thereafter be appro-  
13 priated to the respective agencies upon compliance by the  
14 Governor with Section 6118(e) of the Government Code of Guam,  
15 and upon his report to the Legislature as to the action taken,  
16 if any, on the recommendations dated August 7, 1969 made by  
17 the Federal Comptroller of Guam.

18 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
