available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project or until the project is completed.

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Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Six Hundred Eighty One Thousand Three Hundred and Forty Two Dollars and Twelve Cents (\$681,342,12) for payment of rehabilitation loans: pursuant to Public Law 170, 88th Congress.

Section 5. Section 11001.6 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby renumbered Section 10001.6, and as renumbered is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 10001.6. Public Bids Required. No contract for the construction of public works in which the estimated cost is in excess of \$2,500 shall be executed by the government of Guam unless the same shall have been awarded to the lowest responsible bidder following public solicitation of bids. In the event a contract for the construction of public works is awarded by the government of Guam as a result of negotiation rather than public bidding, the details of the resulting negotiated contract shall be published at least three times in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory prior to the actual execution of the contract, and thereafter any change order affecting the amount to be paid under such negotiated contract shall likewise be so published prior to execution. In addition, prior to the entry of negotiations for the award of such a contract, the intended contract price sought by the government must be publicized at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory so that when the final contract price is published pursuant to the provisions of this section, public notice will be given the

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difference if any between the price sought by the government and the price finally arrived at. Any contract executed in violation of the provisions of this Seltion, or any rules issued in connection therewith, shall be null and void. The Director of Public Works is authorized to issue rules, pursuant to the provisions of the Administrative Adjudication Act, to establish the forms for bid, the minimum publication period which shall not be less than seven days, the methods of publication of the solicitation for bids, and of proposed and accepted negotiated contracts, bid opening methods, the criteria for awarding bids, and such other matters as are required for the implementation hereof."

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Section 6. Effective with the commencement of the 1970 summer session of the University of Guam, administrative officers of the University who are excluded from the benefits of the academic year employment system for instructional faculty members shall receive, during each summer session period, an additional salary equivalent to 25 percent of their base pay, and shall be entitled to eight (8) hours leave with pay for each bi-weekly pay period, during each summer session.

Section 7. There is hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Seven Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Two Dollars (\$7,242) to complete, including toilet facilities, thereto, the bandstand at the Dededo Central Park.

Section 8. Section 2 of Public Law 10-126, Tenth Guam Legislature, is hereby repealed and a new Section 2 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

"Section 2. The provisions of this Act respecting increases in the salaries of Chief Commissioner, Municipal

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Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner, and Judges of the Courts of Guam shall take effect July 1, 1970, while the provisions respecting the salaries of Governor and Lieutenant Governor shall take effect January 1, 1971." Section 9. This Act is an urgency measure.

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
