AN ACT TO AMEND SUBPARAGRAPH (b) OF
SECTION 18005 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM TO LOWER THE MINIMUM WIDTH OF
ROADWAYS IN SUBDIVISIONS UNDER CERTAIN
CONDITIONS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subparagraph (b) of Section 18005 of the
3 Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(b) Cause every lot to abut a roadway right-of-way
5 having a minimum width of forty (40) feet, except that the
6 Commission, may, where circumstances warrant, permit the
7 subdivider to utilize roadway rights-of-way less than
8 forty (40) feet but in no case less than twenty (20) feet
9 in width."
