
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 17603 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO
REZONING HEARINGS AND NOTICES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 17603 of the Government Code of Guam is
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 17603. Hearing date--notice. Upon the
5 filing of an application for change of zone, the Com-
6 mission shall hold at least one hearing thereon in the
7 municipal district where the property to be rezoned is
8 located, as such districts are described in Chapter 1 of
9 Title 16 of this Code, notice of time and place of which
10 shall be given by at least one publication in a newspaper
11 of general circulation, at least ten (10) days before the
12 day of said hearing, and by mail to the commissioner of
13 the municipal district concerned and to those landowners
14 owning land within five hundred (500) feet of the property
15 for which rezoning is requested, the mailing addresses
16 for such landowners to be in the Real Estate Tax records."
