AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 17603 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO REZONING HEARINGS AND NOTICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 17603 of the Government Code of Guam is
hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 17603. Hearing date--notice. Upon the filing of an application for change of zone, the Commission shall hold at least one hearing thereon in the municipal district where the property to be rezoned is located, as such districts are described in Chapter 1 of Title 16 of this Code, notice of time and place of which shall be given by at least one publication in a newspaper of general circulation, at least ten (10) days before the day of said hearing, and by mail to the commissioner of the municipal district concerned and to those landowners owning land within five hundred (500) feet of the property for which rezoning is requested, the mailing addresses for such landowners to be in the Real Estate Tax records."
