AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER 4 TO TITLE XLIV, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO PLACING THE AGANA BOAT BASIN UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby added a new Chapter 4 to Title

XLIV, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Chapter 4

Agana Boat Basin

Section 47250. Administration, The Agana Boat Basin as described in Section 3.of Public Law 86-664, 86th Congress of the United States, is hereby placed under the jurisdiction and control of the Department of Commerce. The Agana Boat Basin shall be used sololy for civic, park and recreational purposes.

Section 47251. Master Plan. The Director of Commerce shall prepare a master plan for proper development of the facilities of the Agana Boat Basin and shall file the same with the Governor and the Legislature. Such plan will include reasonable accurate estimates of the cost involved and recommendations for incremental improvements.

Section 47252. Rules and Regulations. The Director of Commerce shall make such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this Chapter which shall be approved and promulgated by Executive Order.

They shall include, but shall not be limited to, reasonable fees for the use of moorings or berths, prohibitions against habitation of boats within the Agana Boat Basin and procedures for the removal of sunken hulks and the pre-

Section 47253. Violation: Penalty. Every porson who violates, causes or permits to be violated, or fails or refuses to comply with any rule or regulation adopted pursuant to this Chapter, is guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not more more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment of not more than one year, or by both such fine and imprisonment."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
