AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 200 AND 201
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO MAKE
UNIFORM ANNUAL OBSERVANCES OF CERTAIN
LEGAL PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 200 of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 200. Holidays. The holidays of this territory
5 are:

- 6 (a) Every Sunday.
7 (b) New Year's Day, January 1.
8 (c) Washington's Birthday, third Monday in February.
9 (d) Good Friday.
10 (e) Memorial Day, last Monday in May.
11 (f) Independence Day, July 4.
12 (g) Liberation Day, July 21.
13 (h) Labor Day, first Monday in September.
14 (i) Columbus Day, second Monday in October.
15 (j) Veterans Day, fourth Monday in October
16 (k) Thanksgiving Day, fourth Thursday in November.
17 (l) Every day on which an election is held throughout
18 Guam.
19 (m) Christams Day, December 25.
20 (n) Every day appointed by the President of the United
21 States or the Governor of Guam for a public fast,
22 thanksgiving day, or holiday."

23 Section 2. Section 201 of the Government Code of Guam is
24 hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 201. Same. If any of the holidays enumerated in Section 200, (b) through (n), inclusive, falls upon a Sunday, the following Monday is a holiday, and if any of such holidays falls upon a Saturday, the preceding Friday is a holiday."

Section 3. This Act shall take effect January 1, 1971.
