AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 15000 AND 15005  
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE AN  
ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER FOR THE MUNICIPALITY  
OF AGAT AND TO LOWER THE AGE LIMIT FOR  
COMMISSIONERS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 15000 of the Government Code of Guam  
3 is hereby amended, where pertinent, to read as follows:

4	Area	Commissioner	Assistant Commissioner

6	Municipality of Agat	1	1."

7 Section 2. Section 15005 of the Government Code of Guam  
8 is hereby amended to read:

9 "Section 15005. Commissioner(s) and Assistant  
10 Commissioners: Qualifications. The Commissioners and  
11 Assistant Commissioners of Guam shall be citizens of the  
12 United States who have attained the age of twenty-one  
13 years and met the other qualifications prescribed by  
14 Section 15004 for the Chief Commissioner. Commissioners  
15 and Assistant Commissioners must have resided within the  
16 municipality or area which they are to represent for a  
17 period of thirty (30) days immediately preceding the date  
18 of any special or general election at which they are  
19 candidates for election and shall continue to reside  
20 therein throughout their term of office."
