AN ACT

An Act making appropriations for the operations of the Executive, Legislative, and Judicial Branches of the government of Guam for fiscal year ending June 30, 1971; for the operation of the Office of Guam's Washington Representative for calendar year ending December 31, 1971, and to supplement the operational appropriation of the Office of Guam's Washington Representative for calendar year 1970 and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from any available balance in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971, for the purposes set forth hereinafter:

Section 2. Any grant received from the United States of America as general fund revenue is authorized to be expended for the purpose or purposes for which made.

Section 3. Any official or administrative travel for the Executive Branch covered by the appropriations made by Section 1 of this Act shall be limited to the following sums:

A.	For General Governmental Operations	80,000
B.	For Public Safety	6,000
C.	For Conservation of Health	9,000
D.	For Community and Social Services	2,000
E.	For Protection and Development of Resources	12,000

Section 4. The digest of this Act prepared by the Guam Legislature, is attached hereto and is incorporated herein as a recital preceding the enactment clause for the purpose of assisting in the interpretation and implementation of this Act.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for the operation of the Office of Guam's Washington Representative for the calendar year ending December 31, 1971.

Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Ninety Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Forty Seven Dollars (\$97,747) to supplement the appropriation made by Public Law 10-63, Tenth Guam Legislature, for the operation of the Office of Guam's Washington Representative for the calendar year ending December 31, 1970.

Section 7. Section 10 of Public Law 10-153, Tenth Guam Legislature is hereby repealed, and Section 11890 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 11890. Creation of the Legislative Research Bureau. There is within the University of Guam a Legislative Research Bureau for the use of the Legislature under such regulations as the Director of the Bureau with the approval of the Committee on Rules of the Legislature may from time to time provide."
